BEYOND COP21:

AN EDUCATIONAL JOURNEY TOWARDS THE SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT GOALS

As climate change is being felt across the globe and its long term catastrophic impacts have never been so scientifically clear, all eyes have been on the 21st United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC) Conference of Parties (COP21) to finally reach a universal agreement stabilizing greenhouse gas concentrations in the atmosphere at a level that would avoid dangerous climate change.

By attempting to address root causes of human inequality, the recently sanctioned SDGs have made great strides to clarify the connection between climate change and the universal achievement of fundamental human rights.

Looking forward, beyond the negotiations in Paris, how can we best understand and apply the UN's Sustainable Development Goals and the commitments made at COP 21?

In 2016, Target4Green is rolling out a number of different but inter-related educational initiatives for schools and businesses, in support of the SDGs, using interactive learning and practical application.

BEYOND COP 21 ASSEMBLY AND GREEN AMBASSADOR WORKSHOP

A 30 minute whole school assembly presents the key outcomes of COP 21 Paris and explains the importance of the SDGs through strong imagery and personal reflection. This is followed by a 40 minute workshop with 'Green Ambassadors for the SDGs', chosen by the school.

CHILDREN AND ENVIRONMENTAL RIGHTS

This is a half day programme that includes an assembly entitled: Environmental Problems Most Affecting Children, and smaller group workshops, best suited for students from 10-16 years old, that discuss the:

1. The Right to a Voice
2. Wants vs Needs
3. Taking a Rights Based Approach to the Environment

BEYOND COP 21 SYMPOSIUM

Running globally from January 2016, each one day symposium will be hosted by a school, inviting other schools in the area to participate.

The event will consist of themed high impact presentations, guest speakers, networking, pledge making and practical activities/workshops based around the SDGs.

Local, sustainable companies will be invited to show case their products and services.



SUSTAINABILITY IN EDUCATION: A WHOLE SCHOOL COMMUNITY PROGRAMME

This is a full day of activities, cross-curricular lessons, presentations, resource management assessment and CPD, leading to a detailed report in support of action-planning for sustainability within the school.

CORPORATE SUSTAINABILITY WORKSHOP- FROM AN ENVIRONMENTAL AND BUSINESS PERSPECTIVE

This half day workshop looks at the issues facing the planet and how enhanced awareness leads naturally to a more effective, valuable and sustainable approach by companies, as well as improving sustainable business practices.

- It defines what sustainability is in a simple, clear but thought provoking way and focuses on the importance of supporting the SDGs through CSR initiatives.
- With greater understanding of environmental and social issues comes a greater desire to improve the role that Sustainability can play within a company.
- Also included will be case studies of companies who were successful in reducing their costs and carbon footprint.
